The employment contract is permanent contract with the obligation for re-election or election to a higher scientific position every 5 years.

### Requirements:

The candidates have to fulfill the general legal requirements for employment, the conditions prescribed by the Act on Scientific Activity and Higher Education and Regulations on the conditions for a scientist. They need to have experience in managing national and international scientific and research projects related to the activities of the Institute.

In addition, the candidates are required to be qualified for work on the PC in a Windows environment and associated standard programs as well as to have an excellent knowledge of written and spoken Croatian and English language.

In addition to a written application, candidates need to enclose:

- CV with a bibliography (published papers and other works) and a list of projects
- proof of an academic degree
- proof of the promotion to the academic grade according the Article 31 and 41 paragraph 2 of the Act on Scientific Activity and Higher Education

Persons of both sexes may apply under equal opportunities (Article 13. paragraph 2 of the Law on Gender Equality).

The application deadline is 8 days from the date of the announcement of the vacancy in the Official Gazette. Incomplete or belated applications will not be considered.
