The **European Journal of Tourism Research (EJTR)** is a new interdisciplinary scientific journal in the field of tourism. It is a joint publication between International College – Albena, Bulgaria, and World Research Organisation. Its aim is to provide a platform for discussion of theoretical and empirical problems in tourism. Publications from all fields, connected with tourism such as management, marketing, sociology, psychology, geography, political sciences, mathematics, statistics, anthropology, culture, information technologies and others are invited.

The **EJTR** is open to all researchers. Young researchers and authors from Central and Eastern Europe are encouraged to submit their contributions.

Regular Articles in **EJTR** should normally be between 4000 and 20000 words. Major research articles of between 10000 and 20000 are highly welcome. Longer or shorter papers will also be considered. The **EJTR** publishes also Research Notes of 1500-2000 words. Submitted papers must combine theoretical concepts with practical applications or empirical testing. The **EJTR** includes also the following sections: *Book Reviews*, announcements for *Conferences and Seminars*, abstracts of successfully defended *Ph. D. Theses in Tourism*, case studies of *Tourism Best Practices*.
