## Zagreb, 05.10.2015.

In period 01. - 02. 10. 2015, at the Institute for Tourism organized first transnational project meeting, which marked the beginning of the implementation of the "Rooms to VET - Upskilling and Professionalization of private tourism accommodation services". The main objective of the project is to raise the quality of private accommodation through establishing educational requirements and curriculum development of lifelong education and training providers of private accommodation.

"Rooms to VET" project is funded by European Commission and is being implemented by nine partners from five countries: Croatia, Slovenia, Greece, Spain and Cyprus. All countries are characterized by a high share of private accommodation in total accommodation facilities and relatively low quality of private accommodation. Therefore, the main objective of the "Rooms to VET" project is to raise the knowledge, skills and competencies of service providers and to raise the overall level of quality of private accommodation, and thus the degree of market competitiveness of tourism product in the partner countries.
